REGISTRATION FOR SECOND ANNUAL “ANGEL RUN” BEGINS SEPTEMBER 13

*Festive, holiday season 5k family “fun run/walk” through
Medfield will be held on Sunday, December 2*

MEDFIELD, MA, Sept. 13, 2007 – Advance registration opens today for the second annual Angel Run, a five kilometer (3.2 miles) “fun run/walk” through Medfield, to be held on Sunday, December 2, 2007. Runners and walkers of all ages and abilities are welcome to participate in this family-oriented, holiday season community event. Registration forms can be downloaded from the Angel Run web site, www.angelrun.org. Forms also will be available at various area merchants and at the Angel Run booth (#94) at Medfield Day on Saturday, September 15.

The Angel Run is a community *fun raiser* – a family event designed to bring members of the extended Medfield community together. The inaugural Angel Run in December, 2006 drew about 1,000 runners and walkers, and many more entertainers, helpers and spectators.

Like Boston's famous Jingle Bell Run, the Angel Run is a celebration of the season. Runners and spectators are encouraged to attend in holiday garb. Festive decorations will adorn the course, carolers will entertain runners and spectators alike, and water stations along the route will be events unto themselves. Runners and spectators are invited to attend a post-run party at the Wheelock School.

The Angel Run will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, December 2, 2007. The route, which differs slightly from last year's, begins and ends at the Ralph Wheelock Elementary School in Medfield, and traverses a course of level terrain and modest hills on the surrounding roads. (Several roads will be closed to vehicular traffic while the Angel Run is in progress.) A shorter, one mile loop will be available for strollers, young children and their adult escorts. The Angel Run was conceived by friends of Natasha Domeshek, an 8-year-old Medfield third grade student who died in 2002, as a way to celebrate Natasha's spirit during her favorite time of year and around her birthday. The Natasha Domeshek Fund was established to fund services for families in need and a scholarship for the Medfield High School Class of 2012.
